FOR THE WEEK CATTLE SALUGHTER WAS DOWN 13,000 HEAD COMPARED TO THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND DOWN 33,367 HEAD COMPARED TO THE SAME PERIOD A YEAR AGO. THIS WEEK PACKERS WILL BE BUYING CATTLE FOR THE SHORT KILL WEEK WITH THANKSGIVING ON THURSDAY NOVEMBER 28<sup>TH</sup>.

PACKERS BOUGHT CATTLE LOWER LAST WEEK AS BEEF PRICES CONTINUED TO BREAK. AS OF FRIDAY CHOICE BEEF WAS DOWN \$4.59 FOR THE WEEK COMPARED TO A WEEK AGO. THE CME BOXED BEEF INDEX WAS DOWN \$5.22.

FRIDAY PACKERS WERE CLEANING UP THE BUY AND BOUGHT SCATTERED AMOUNTS ACROSS THE REGIONS STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER THAN THURSDAY. CATTLE IN KANSAS AND TEXAS WERE \$185.00 AND MIDWEST CATTLE HAD A RANGE FROM 182.00-185.00. BREAKING FOR LIGHTS AND HEAVY CATTLE AND GRADE. DRESSED PRICES FROM \$290 TO \$298 WITH THE AVERAGE AROUND \$290. CASH PRICES \$2.00 TO \$3.00 LOWER AND DRESSED DOWN \$2.00 TO \$6.00 LOWER.

THE WEIGHT GAIN ON CATTLE IS GOING TO BE PROBLEM ESPECIALLY WHEN THE HOLIDAYS ARE OVER AND DEMAND FOR RIB AND LOIN PRIMALS DROP AND CONSUMERS ARE LOOKING FOR CHEAP BEEF. THE LONGR FEEDLOTS KEEP CATTLE ON FEED, THE MORE THEY FALL INTO THE PACKERS HANDS. PACKERS ARE LOSING MONEY WITHH CATTLE. THEY ARE MAKING MONEY WITH HOGS AND POULTRY. COMPANIES THAT HAVE ALL 3 SPECIES ARE GOING TO FAVOR HOGS AND POULTRY. COMPANIES THAT KILL JUST CATTLE ARE GOING TO HAVE A HARD TIME.

AS OF NOVEMBER 12,2024, DRESSED STEER AND HEIFER CARCASSES AVERAGED 927.3 POUNDS, UP 2.9 POUNDS FROM PREVIOUS WEEK, AND <u>UP 37.0 POUNDS</u> FROM A YEAR AGO. THE GRADING PERCENT AS OF 11/12/2024 WAS 81.8% COMPARED TO PREVIOUS WEEK AT 80.8% AND UP 1.4% OVER A YEAR AGO AT 80.4%.

Sterling Marketing uses the Comprehensive Beef Cutout Value reported by USDA. I have included a document that explains this cutout value. I looked at this value about 4 years ago and compared the beef packer margin values from my Choice-Select Adjusted value and this Comprehensive value. There was little difference. However, over the past few weeks, the difference has become significant. I believe this is because the mix of cattle slaughtered is increasingly includes higher valued cattle – i.e., Prime, Upper 2/3 Choice, and Branded Program cattle. In addition, it includes the formula-priced cattle. Using just the Choice and higher grade and Select grade to generate the cutout does not reflect this important difference in the quality of cattle which in turn is definitely a driver to the notable improvement in beef demand over the past year.

PORK PRICES ARE MOVING LOWER LED BUY LOINS, HAMS BELLIES. HAMS AND BELLIES IN OCTOBER WERE THE LEADERS AS PRICES MOVED UP BUT NOW, THE TOP PRODUCTS, OF THE CARCASS, LOINS, HAMS, AND BELLIES ARE PUSHING PRICES DOWN.

TO TOP IT OFF, PORK IS GOING DOWN FASTER THAN HOGS. PACKERS ARE NOT GOING TO BE HAPPY.

LAST WEEK'S LOW PORK EXPORTS AND THE LOWER PRICES FOR FRESH HAMS AND BELLIES HAVE SOME ANALYSTS BELIEVING THAT EXPORT BUYERS MAY HAVE BEGUN TO BUY LESS PORK AHEAD OF POSSIBLE TARRIFS.
